

# ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY CALENDAR FOR 2001

## JANUARY

- L 1** EPCRA: **Supplier** must give notice to each recipient of certain mixtures or trade name products containing listed toxic chemicals with first shipment of the calendar year. 40 C.F.R. § 372.45.
- 1** TSCA: **Exporters** of certain chemicals regulated under sections 4 and 5(b) must give notice to EPA with first export of calendar year. 40 C.F.R. § 707.65.
- 21** CAA: Semiannual reports described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners and operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant emission controls for equipment leaks from **Group V** chemical process units. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.100(k)(3), 63.182(d)(1).
- 22** CAA: Semiannual reports described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners and operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant emission controls for equipment leaks from **Group I** chemical process units. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.100(k), 63.182(d)(1).
- 23** CAA: Semiannual reports described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners and operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant emission controls for equipment leaks from **Group III** chemical process units. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.100(k), 63.182(d)(1).
- 29** CWA: Facility owner/operators previously covered by the 1995 Multi-Sector General Permit must update their **Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans**. For facilities currently covered by the 1995 MSGP, Notices of Intent requesting coverage under the reissued MSGP must be submitted. 65 Fed. Reg. 64,746, 66 Fed. Reg. 1675.

## FEBRUARY

- L 1** OSHA: Affected employers to post for one month **summary** of occupational **injuries and illnesses** occurring during 2000. 29 C.F.R. § 1904.5(d)(1).
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L Actions of general, widespread applicability.

## MARCH

- 1** RCRA: Annual reports due from primary **exporters** of hazardous waste. 40 C.F.R. § 262.56(a).
- L 1** RCRA: **Annual ground water monitoring report** due from owners/operators of certain interim status surface impoundments, landfills, or land treatment facilities managing hazardous waste. 40 C.F.R. § 265.94(a)(2)(ii)-(iii).
- L 1** EPCRA: **Annual Tier I and Tier II inventory reports** due for any facility that had hazardous chemicals present at a facility in an amount equal to or greater than 10,000 pounds at any time during the preceding year. 40 C.F.R. §§ 370.20(b)(2), 370.25(a).
- 15** RCRA: Annual report due from facilities conducting **treatability studies**. 40 C.F.R. § 261.4(f)(9).
- 15** CAA: Semiannual monitoring report due on certain mercury **chlor-alkali** plant activities. 40 C.F.R. § 61.55(b)(7)-(8).
- 16** CAA: Semiannual inspection and monitoring reports due from owners/operators of certain petroleum refining process units and related air emission sources that were constructed on or before July 14, 1994, and are subject to the **petroleum refining NESHAP**. 40 C.F.R. 63.10(d)(5), 63.654(g), (h)(1).
- 21** CAA: Owners and operators of certain sources that produce **pharmaceutical products and intermediates** and that commenced construction or reconstruction on or before April 2, 1997 must submit a Precompliance Report to EPA. 40 C.F.R. § 63.1260(e)

## APRIL

- 16** CAA: Semiannual reports due from owners/operators of certain new sources that commenced construction or reconstruction after April 2, 1997, and are subject to the **pharmaceutical products and intermediates** NESHAP. 40 C.F.R. § 63.1260(g); 63 Fed. Reg. 50,280.
- 16** CAA: Owners and operators of existing sources within the **pulp and paper production** source category must comply with NESHAPs and MACT

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requirements and implement written startup, shutdown and malfunction plans. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.6(e)(3), 63.440(d); 63 Fed. Reg. 18,506.

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CAA: Semiannual report described at 40 C.F.R. § 182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners/operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant controls for equipment leaks from **Group II or IV chemical process units**. 40 C.F.R. § 63.182(d)(1).

MAY

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CAA: Semiannual report described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.152(c)(2)-(4) due from owners/operators of **new sources** that commence construction or reconstruction after December 31, 1992 and are subject to organic hazardous air pollutant emission controls under 40 C.F.R. Part 63, Subpart G, for **synthetic organic chemical** manufacturing industry production processes. 40 C.F.R. § 63.152(c), (d).

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CAA: Owners/operators of certain sources that produce **pharmaceutical products and intermediates** and commenced construction on or before April 2, 1997 must submit **requests for extensions** if they desire up to one year to comply with NESHAPs and MACT requirements.

JUNE

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CAA: Semiannual inspection and monitoring reports due from owners/operators of certain petroleum refining process units and related air emission sources that commenced construction or reconstruction after July 14, 1994 and are subject to the **petroleum refining NESHAP**. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.10(d)(5), 63.654(g), (h)(1).

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CAA: Owners and operators of **Department of Energy facilities** described at 40 C.F.R. § 61.90 to report monitoring results, dose calculations, and other information to EPA. 40 C.F.R. §§ 61.93(a), 61.94(a), 61.94(b)(1)-(9).

RSPA: **Shippers** of certain **hazardous materials** must submit registrations and annual fees to the Department of Transportation. 49 C.F.R. §§ 107.601 to 107.620.

JULY

L 1

EPCRA: **Annual Form R toxic release report** due for all substances subject to Section 313 of EPCRA. 40 C.F.R. § 372.30(d).

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TSCA: **Annual PCB** report due from certain facilities using, storing, or disposing of PCBs. 40 C.F.R. § 761.180.

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CAA: Semiannual report described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners/operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant controls for equipment leaks from **Group V** chemical process units. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.100(k)(3), 63.182(d)(2)-(4).

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CAA: Semiannual report described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners/operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant controls for equipment leaks from **Group I** chemical process units. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.100(k)(3), 63.182(d)(1).

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CAA: Semiannual report described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners/operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant controls for equipment leaks from **Group III** chemical process units. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.100(k)(3), 63.182(d)(1).

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EPCRA: **Revisions to Form R** must be submitted by owners/operators subject to toxic chemical release reporting requirements who wish publicly available data to show such revisions. 40 C.F.R. Part 372, 64 Fed. Reg. 20,198.

AUGUST

SEPTEMBER

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CAA: Semiannual and monitoring reports due from owners/operators of certain petroleum refining process units and related air emission sources that were constructed on or before July 14, 1994, and are subject to the **petroleum refining NESHAP**. 40 C.F.R. 63.10(d)(5), 63.654(g), (h)(1).

**15** CAA: Semiannual monitoring reports due on certain mercury cell **chlor-alkali** plant activities. 40 C.F.R. § 61.55(b)(7)-(8).

**21** CAA: Owners and operators of certain sources that produce **pharmaceutical products and intermediates** and commenced construction or reconstruction on or before April 2, 1997 must comply with NESHAPs and MACT requirements. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.6(e)(3), 63.1250(f); 63 Fed. Reg. 50,280.

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## OCTOBER

**1** RSPA: As of this date, **shippers of hazardous materials** must comply with revised **placarding** requirements. 49 C.F.R. §§ 171.14(b), 172.502, 172.510, 172.540, 172.555; 62 Fed. Reg. 1,217, 62 Fed. Reg. 39,398.

**16** CAA: Semiannual reports due from owners/ operators of certain new sources that commenced construction or reconstruction after April 2, 1997, and are subject to the **pharmaceutical products and intermediates** NESHAP. 40 C.F.R. § 63.1260(g); 63 Fed. Reg. 50,280.

**22** CAA: Semiannual report described at 40 C.F.R. § 182(d)(2)-(4) due from owners/operators of existing sources subject to organic hazardous air pollutant controls for equipment leaks from Group II or IV chemical process units. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.100(k), 63.182(d)(1).

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## NOVEMBER

**1** TSCA: Annual test for **PCB** concentrations in **hydraulic systems** that ever contained PCBs at concentrations greater than 50 ppm. 40 C.F.R. § 761.30(e)(1).

**19** CAA: Semiannual report described at 40 C.F.R. § 63.152(c)(2)-(4) due from owners/operators of new sources that commence construction or reconstruction after December 31, 1992 and are subject to hazardous organic air pollutant emission controls under 40 C.F.R. Part 63, Subpart G, for **synthetic organic chemical manufacturing** industry processes. 40 C.F.R. § 63.152(c), (d).

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## DECEMBER

**3** CAA: Owners/operators of **benzene storage vessels** with an **external floating roof** and having a liquid-mounted primary seal but are without a secondary seal are required to measure gaps between the vessel wall and the primary seal. 40 C.F.R. § 62.272(b)(1)(ii).

**14** CAA: Semiannual inspection and monitoring reports due from owners/operators of certain petroleum refining process units and related air emission sources that commenced construction or reconstruction after July 14, 1994 and are subject to the **petroleum refining NESHAP**. 40 C.F.R. §§ 63.10(d)(5), 63.654(g), (h)(1).
